All the theoretical shifts are minutely observed, compared and contrasted in the writings under research. He cogently argues that the basic impulse underlying Marx's works from the beginning to the end is humanistic, the doctrine of alienation being essential in the whole corpus of his works. This book makes a significant contribution to understand a central and continuing problem of modern man and his world through the perspective of Marx, the great advocate and philosopher of human fulfilment and freedom.
